More and more people are choosing to be married or form a civil partnership outdoors. Legal ceremonies are now allowed to take place outdoors or in a temporary or moveable structure, such as marquees, boats and more. providing they are on approved licensed premises.

Our staff will be happy to discuss any ideas that you have to make your ceremony unique to you.

Wherever, and however, you decide to celebrate your special day, from traditional and stylish to themed or more unusual, you will be guaranteed the ultimate venue and spectacular backdrop.

All civil ceremonies, either in a Registration Office or Approved Venue, are arranged through the Registration Service. However, it is the responsibility of the couple to book the Approved Venue.

Our Registration Offices are all different in character and capacity, and our Ceremonies Team know how to make your day really special, priding themselves on making each ceremony a unique experience to treasure.

Please feel free to discuss any ideas of your own with the Ceremonies Team prior to the day.

In a civil marriage there are certain words prescribed by law, which you must say, known as declaratory and contracting words. In a civil partnership, it is optional whether these words are said out loud. However, there are various ways of personalising your ceremony, such as additional vows which may be added after the contractual words have been spoken.

You must provide two witnesses, who may be either friends or relatives. It is advisable that they should be over the age of 18, and are able to understand English as well as the significance of the ceremony they are witnessing.

They will be asked to sign the marriage schedule or civil partnership schedule at the end of the ceremony.

Please note:

On this special day please help us and other couples who are holding a ceremony on the same day by arriving at the Registration Office or Approved Venue, at the appropriate time.

The groom/partner is expected 30 minutes before the ceremony and the bride/partner should arrive 15 minutes before the start. The Registration Service staff will often need to attend other ceremonies on the day.

Should the services of an interpreter be required, please contact the Ceremonies Team for advice.

Please note: if the ceremony is to take place anywhere other than an approved venue, the location must have public liability insurance in place and may need to be inspected before a ceremony can be approved.

What is included?

- Your legal marriage ceremony or Civil Partnership
- Options available for your ceremony or Civil Partnership to be held at a licensed venue or at one of our service points across Cumbria
- A personalised ceremony script including 'your story', readings, personalised vows, ceremony gestures or musical performances to suit your wishes
- A longer ceremony time of up to 60 minutes
- A meeting with your ceremony officer prior to the ceremony
- A Commemorative certificate signed by your witnesses presented to you as a keepsake of your special day.

Not included:

Statutory fees payable for the legal preliminaries for Notice of Marriage, Civil Partnership or Legal Certificates.

What if my chosen venue doesn't have a licence to hold weddings?

If your chosen venue doesn't have a licence, our Bespoke Ceremony options allow for a legal Ceremony to be carried out at a register office either on the same day or on an alternative day followed by a unique event allowing you to Celebrate in Style.

How do I book?

Use the blue enquiry button, which once completed and submitted will be sent directly to one of our staff who will contact you about your enquiry.

In Cumbria you may provisionally book your ceremony up to 24 months in advance with a non-refundable deposit.

Once a booking has been made, there would be an administration fee for any changes. This fee is in addition to the standard fees payable to the Registrar, and couples must still give notice within 12 months of the ceremony in the usual way.

You can include music which is special to you. It must not be religious in nature.

Many of our Approved Venues are set amidst breathtaking landscapes and beautiful gardens in which to have your photographs taken.

The ceremonies co-ordinator at an Approved Venue will be delighted to discuss various arrangements that can be made to make your day really special.



Ceremonies at Approved Venues follow a similar format to those in the Registration Offices. To arrange a ceremony at an Approved Venue you must first contact the premises of your choice to make provisional arrangements and check that they have availability.

It is advisable to request three or four alternative dates and times, as it is not always possible to accommodate your first choice.

You must then contact the Ceremonies Team to ensure that a member of the team is able to attend your ceremony on that date and time. Information about formal notice can be given to you at the time of booking.

CIVIL PARTNERSHIPS

PLANNING YOUR CIVIL PARTNERSHIP IN CUMBRIA

Civil Partnerships have now been extended to all couples from December 2019.

Civil Partnerships are available to both same-sex couples and opposite sex couples. Whereas a marriage is formed by vows, a civil partnership is formed by the signing of a civil partnership document.

Registering a civil partnership will give your relationship legal recognition. This will give you added legal rights and pension benefits, as well as responsibilities.

You can celebrate the formation of your civil partnership in any of our licensed premises or register offices in Cumbria.

How far in advance can I make a booking?

A legal notice of the formation of a civil partnership is valid for twelve months. However, in Cumbria you are able to make a provisional booking for the formation of your partnership, up to two years in advance.

Please note that there is a non-refundable deposit payable at the time of booking.

Legal Preliminaries

Before you can form your civil partnership, there are certain formalities which are required under law. You must both attend the Register Office in the district in which you live to inform them of your

intention to form a civil partnership. This is called giving notice and you must attend in person.

You will each be required to give an individual notice.

After giving notice you must allow at least 28 clear days before the formation can take place. Your civil partnership formation must then take place within twelve months of the date you gave at the notice.

Fees and charges

Fees are dependent on the day of the week. Please see our website www.cumbria.gov.uk/registrationservice/fees for a full list of fees.

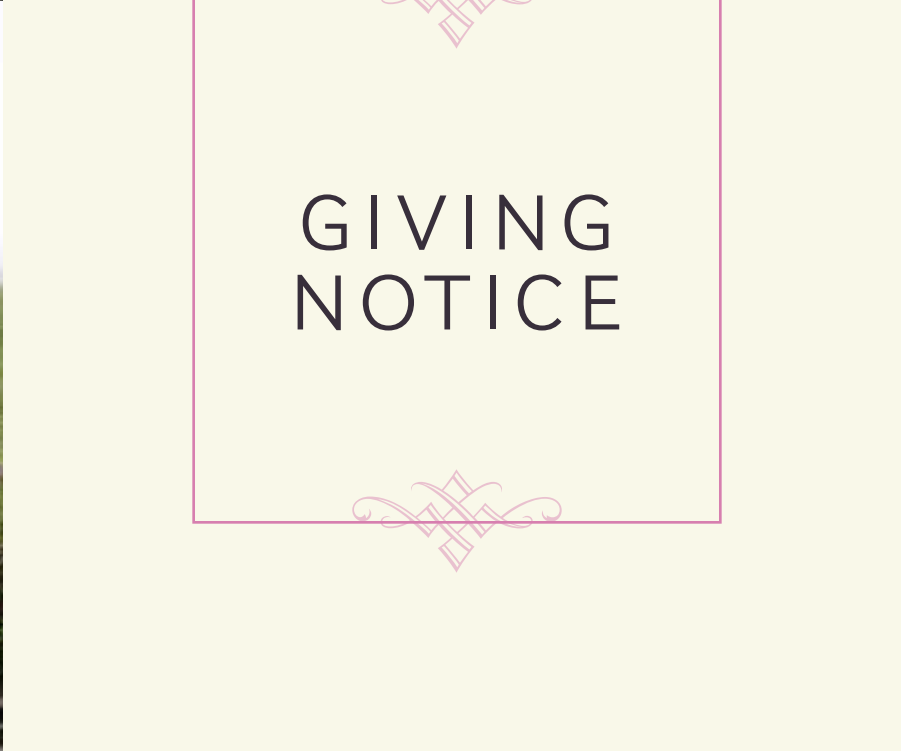

Each couple must give notice. Giving notice means making a legal declaration that you are both free to marry each other or form a civil partnership and you will need to provide certain documents and prove this when doing so.

Although you may have a civil ceremony in any district within England and Wales, you must give notice to the Registrar in the district where you live.

When you wish to give formal notice you will need to make an appointment at the appropriate office and it will take approximately half an hour to an hour to complete.

When you attend your appointment you and your partner will need to provide information including proof of age, nationality and evidence you are free to marry or form a civil partnership. You will also need to provide documents that prove your identity.

When you book an appointment our officers will advise you of what you need to bring with you.

For more detailed information please visit our website www.cumbria.gov.uk/registration

If either of you are under 18, the Registrar will give you forms that must be completed by a parent or legal guardian. If you are in any doubt about the paperwork required, please contact a member of our Ceremonies Team for further advice.

Whilst you can book your ceremony more than a year in advance, your notice of intent can only be given within one year of the date. Our Ceremony Team can advise you of the minimum number of days in advance you may give your notice. Once the notice of intent has been given, your details will be publicly displayed at the Register Office for 28 days.

However, for administrative purposes we recommend you allow a minimum of eight weeks.

There is a minimum period between giving notice and getting married or forming a civil partnership – please ask our Ceremony Team for further details.

Both of you must give notice and this must be done in person at the appropriate Registration Office. In general, notice must be given in the district where you live.

If you both live in the same district a joint appointment should be made with your local office. If you live in separate districts, but still within England or Wales then you should make individual appointments with your local Registration Office, if possible around the same date.

You must be resident in the district where you give notice for the preceding eight days prior to the appointment and on the ninth day you will be free to give notice.

If you wish to have a ceremony in a district where you do not live, you will need to contact both the venue and the Registrar of that district to make arrangements, and agree the date and time of your ceremony. Once you have done this you can then give your notice to marry or form a civil partnership to the Registrar in the district where you live.

The Registrar will tell you when your marriage authority or schedule will be issued.

If you are getting married or forming a civil partnership in another district, please advise the Registrar where to send your authorities.

Please be aware that some special conditions may apply in the following cases:

- Either party is not a British Citizen
- If the marriage/civil partnership is to take place outside of England or Wales
- Or if either party is resident outside of England or Wales.

If any of the above applies to you or your partner please contact one of our Registration Offices for further advice.

Immigration Control

If one or both of you is subject to immigration control you will need to follow special procedures. You will need to give notice at a specially designated Registration Office.

Most importantly, please note that it is your responsibility to arrange the following:

- To book any Approved Venue and arrange the details of the day
- To ensure that the legal formalities are completed in sufficient time to allow the ceremony to proceed.

OUTDOOR CEREMONIES



More and more people are now choosing to be married or form a civil partnership outdoors. Until recently, civil marriages had to take place inside or under a permanent licenced structure. Due to a change in legislation we are now able to conduct ceremonies at licenced premises in their outdoor areas without the need for a licenced structure. The areas still have to be prior approved before any legal ceremony, so please speak to your venue regarding the outside areas available. If your venue does not hold an approved venue licence, please speak to us about a Bespoke package.

Please remember that, with the great British summer being what it is, it will not always be possible to hold a ceremony outdoors due to inclement weather, which may include rain, wind or even very hot and sunny conditions with no shade.

It will be the Registrars' decision on the day whether the ceremony can take place outdoors. They will need to consider the safety and wellbeing of the guests as well as the protection of the Schedule, which is the only official record of the ceremony.

Please do not let it spoil your day if the ceremony cannot take place outdoors for whatever reason. Make sure you have a back-up plan and select another room at the venue and remember, it should be big enough to accommodate all your guests.

REMEMBER REMEMBER

- Payment for any ceremony is required in advance, 12 weeks prior to the day
- If the ceremony will take place within 12 weeks, full payment is required at the time of booking
- It is the responsibility of the couple to book, and confirm, dates and arrangements with Approved Venues, and to pay any fees due to the premises
- It is the couple's responsibility to ensure that the legal formalities and notices are complete and that you have obtained the necessary authorities before your ceremony
- Any rights of copyright for music, readings, etc., permitted at the ceremony are a matter for you and the venue
- A booking cannot be made unless you are legally free to marry or form a civil partnership (i.e. divorced or granted a dissolution) and are in receipt of any papers to prove this
- Whilst every effort will be made to make sure your ceremony starts on time, you should appreciate that circumstances beyond the control of the Registration Service staff may occasionally cause delays.
- It is very important that you and your guests arrive in good time, at least 30 minutes before the start of your ceremony. This will allow you to be interviewed before the ceremony and for your guests to be seated. The Registrar will see you privately, either together or separately, to check details and final arrangements.
- We make every effort to perform the ceremony at the time stated. As our staff may have other ceremonies after yours, any unnecessary delays may result in them having to leave to attend other ceremonies.

Unfortunately, the Registration Service cannot accept responsibility for any delays beyond its control.

COPY CERTIFICATES

Couples often require more than one copy of their marriage or civil partnership certificate, primarily for legal purposes. Certificates are no longer issued on the day of the ceremony, these can be purchased after the ceremony through the Registration Office in the district where your ceremony took place or direct from the General Register Office.

Don't forget you may need to change your passport. Check with your travel agent or the country's consulate if you are travelling abroad for your honeymoon. You can change your passport details at any time within three months before the ceremony, although you will not be able to use it, until after your ceremony. For further information, please check www.gov.uk

MUSIC

You can choose your own recorded music to be played upon entrance of the bride/partners, at the signing of the register and as an exit from the ceremony. Music and/or readings must be approved prior to your ceremony by the ceremonies team via the ceremony planner. Recorded music must be supplied by the couple and played on your own device, or arrangements for playing made prior to the ceremony with the venue. Music which has any religious connotations or is deemed inappropriate for a civil ceremony will not be permitted. Cumbria County Council are not responsible for providing or playing music.

WORDS & READINGS

You can choose to say special words to each other and add readings to your traditional or bespoke ceremony.

TRADITIONAL CEREMONY:
Two readings or personalised vows.

BESPOKE CEREMONY:
Personalised ceremony script which can include vows, readings and gestures.

WITNESSES

You need to provide at least two witnesses over 18 years of age at your ceremony. They may be relatives, friends or colleagues who must be able to speak and understand English and also the significance of the ceremony.

PARKING

The availability of parking varies at each Registration Office. For further information, please contact the Ceremonies Team. Most Approved Venues have ample parking.

PHOTOS

Official photographers are welcome to take photographs before and after the formal ceremony, however it is important that all ceremonies begin on time, without delays as a result of photographs being taken.

All photography, professional or otherwise, is by the permission of the presiding Ceremonies Officers and must be agreed prior to the start of the ceremony.

It is permitted to photograph the couple as they enter, during the exchange of ring(s) and the first kiss. Flashguns may only be used with the consent of the Ceremonies Team.

VIDEO

Video recording is at the discretion of the Ceremonies Team. Only one video camera to be used and the person recording the event should remain in one position. Any cameras or video equipment must be battery operated only.

MOBILE PHONES

Your guests will be asked to ensure that their mobile phones or electrical devices are silent or turned off during the ceremony.

CONFETTI

Confetti is a familiar part of any wedding, but please ask your guests not to throw confetti inside the building!

NO SMOKING

Cumbria County Council has a no smoking policy on all its premises and this includes all Registration Offices, ceremony rooms, car parks and grounds.

INSURANCE

If, for whatever reason, you need to change your plans, it could be extremely expensive. We would recommend you take out the appropriate insurance.

TIMING

We require where possible that the groom/partner is at the venue a minimum of half an hour before the ceremony. The bride/partner 15 minutes before the allocated starting time.

For couples who may be staying/ changing at the venue, we would ask you to ensure that you are fully dressed with hair/makeup completed 30 minutes prior to the ceremony for the interview with the registrar.

ANIMALS

Animals or birds are not permitted in any register office. The use of any animal or birds at a ceremony in a licensed venue is at the discretion of the owner/manager of the premises. We must be advised in writing of the use of any animal or bird in a ceremony at least 6 weeks in advance.

An opportunity for couples to renew their commitment to each other in a non-religious celebratory ceremony.

This can be used on a special anniversary, such as 10th, 25th or 40th or after an original low-key wedding, thus enabling family and friends who were unable to attend, to enjoy the celebrations and become involved.

Our Celebrant ceremonies are often held after a ceremony abroad.

Options could include a twilight ceremony or themed celebration. As this is a non legal ceremony the possibilities are endless.

Any couple of any age or gender can arrange a celebratory ceremony. Couples do not have to live in Cumbria. You will have the chance to work closely with a professional ceremony planner to select from the options available, and tailor a ceremony that is special for you and your family.

Every ceremony is different, so you can create something unique for you to remember and treasure.

We offer celebratory ceremonies in all Registration Offices and approved premises within the county.

If you would like to use a different venue, for example a village hall, or a marquee in the grounds of a hotel or the garden at your home, this would need to be discussed beforehand.

The location selected must have public liability and may need to be inspected before a ceremony can be approved.

NAMING

Any parent can make arrangements to hold a naming ceremony.

Whether married or not, or from different religious or cultural backgrounds, you can host a naming ceremony to celebrate with your family. Ceremonies can also be used to introduce adoptive children and stepchildren into a new relationship and form part of the family bonding with an extended family unit.

You may choose to hold it prior to or following your wedding or civil partnership ceremony.

A naming ceremony provides an opportunity to:

Welcome the child or children into the family and wider community

Announce the names that have been chosen, and maybe give the reasons behind the choice

Make promises of commitment to nurture and support the child into adult life

Choose other adults prepared to promise a special supportive relationship to the child or children

Gather together close family and friends to celebrate the special occasion.

You may choose from a selection of poems and readings to enhance the ceremony and you can present your child with a special gift to mark the occasion.

Registration Offices and Approved Venues which are licensed for civil marriages or civil partnerships are listed in this brochure. They provide excellent locations and meet current fire and safety regulations with public liability insurance.

These premises are experienced at holding events and are also ideal for naming ceremonies, however, there may be other options. If you are unsure of the suitability of a particular location please contact the Ceremonies Team.

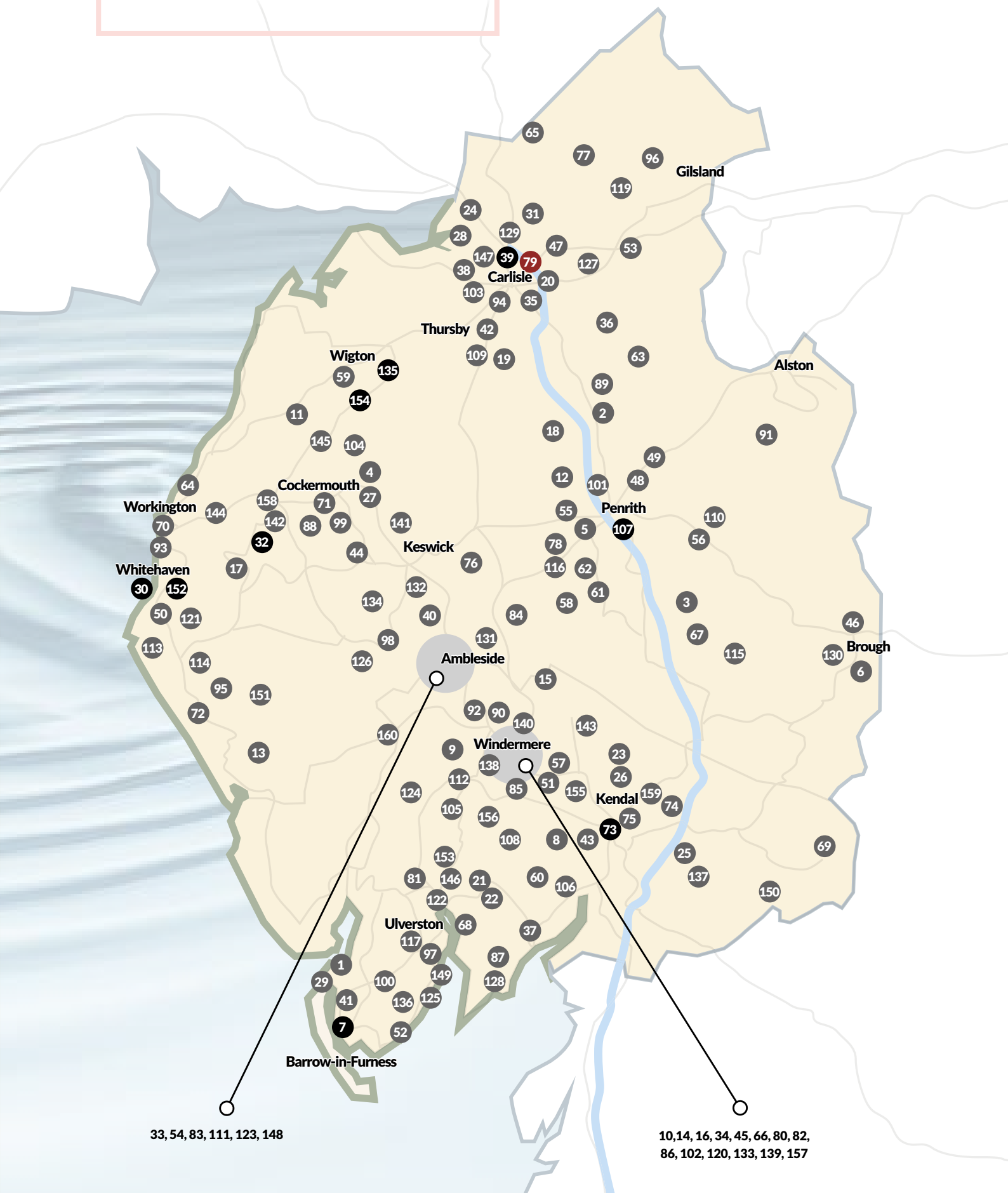
